## News from Altrusa International

### Payment of Dues

International has adjusted the payment of dues for 2020- 2021. We now have the option to make two payments of our International dues; the 1<sup>st</sup> half to be paid July 1<sup>st</sup> and the second half by November 30, 2020. Young Professionals will continue to pay half dues but have the option of paying no later than November 30, 2020. District Eleven is following these same guidelines regarding District dues. District Treasurer, Leslie Johnson has provided Club Presidents and Treasurers with a Membership Assistance Form for those members whose ability to pay their International and District dues have been compromised by COVID-19. The payment of **club dues** will continue to be the responsibility of each club. You may choose to waive or defer club dues as best meets the needs of your club and ensures continued membership. All members who can pay their dues by June 1<sup>st</sup> are encouraged to do so.

### Club Annual Report

The Club Annual Report for the 2019-2020 year has been reworked to address the current circumstances during these uncertain times. Each of you should have received the form to be completed by June 15<sup>th</sup>. ### Sponsors Recognition Pins

Sponsors Recognition Pins are back. In addition, a new pin has been introduced called the Altrusa Gold Medal. Credit for this pin will accumulate beginning June 1, 2009. To earn the Altrusa Gold Medal a member must receive Sponsor Credit for ten new members on or after June 1, 2009. Pins in the shape of even-numbers will be awarded to members in increments of two until they reach the eight number. ### Altrusa Club Disaster Recovery Service Grant

The Altrusa International Foundation provides opportunities for Altrusa Clubs worldwide to address the unmet and otherwise unfunded needs of a community or area following a disaster. Applications for these grants shall be initiated by an Altrusa Club President submitted to the District Governor for approval, then forwarded to the International Foundation office for review by the Board of Trustees. Disasters funded with these grants should serve an area affecting at least 100 individuals. There is no maximum to the amount you can request. There is one tier of the Disaster Relief Fund that allows the Foundation Chair to immediately disburse up to \$1,000 without the board's approval. But you, or your clubs, may request more, if needed.
